From Niagara Falls

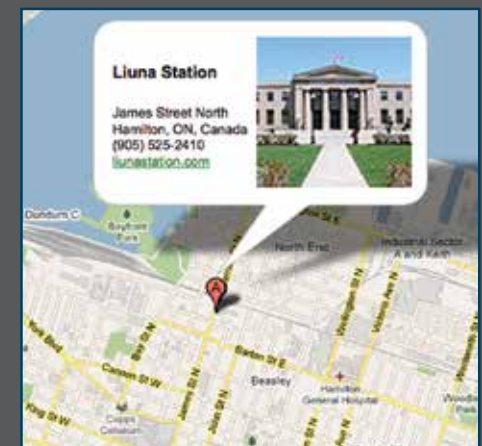
- QEW Toronto to Burlington Street.
