

Department of Medicine promotes Clinician Investigator Program

The McMaster Department of Medicine, a recognized leader in research, is pleased to announce a new initiative designed to foster the education of upcoming clinician scientists. Funding opportunities are now available in two formats to support the development of research leaders through the Clinician Investigator Program (CIP).

- The Department of Medicine will provide the opportunity to match funding from divisions or subspecialties in support of residents entering the CIP.
- One individual annually may apply to the Department for full funding equivalent to the MOHLTC level of support while pursuing a degree through the CIP.

The Clinician Investigator Program provides intensive research opportunities for applicants who are currently registered in an RCPSC-accredited Specialty / Subspecialty Program and is intended for future academic clinicians planning to conduct research as a key component of their medical career.
