<p><b>Description of Elective Experience</b></p>	<p>Electives are available and could include the following components:</p> <p>Interviewing and/or observing children, parents, caregivers, Social Workers around issues of maltreatment in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- CAAP Comprehensive Clinic - Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday</li> <li>- Medical Care Clinic – Available Daily</li> <li>- Ward Consults</li> <li>- CAAP Case Conference</li> <li>- Agency Case Conferences off site</li> </ul>
<p><b>Number of Students</b></p>	<p>1 per rotation</p>
<p><b>Duration of Elective (i.e. available for 2 to 4 weeks)</b></p>	<p>Minimum of three weeks is preferred, however, will consider 2 weeks based on availability</p>
<p><b>Black-Out Dates (If applicable)</b></p>	<p>August and December</p>
<p><b>Limited Availability Dates (If applicable)</b></p>	<p>Case per case basis</p>
<p><b>Current Limitations (If applicable)</b></p>	<p>Based on the number of learners doing their rotation at the time</p>
