Description of Elective Experience	<p>Electives are available and could include the following components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will primarily be responsible for hospital inpatients for who the paediatric ID service is consulted. They will be expected to do full history/physicals, generate a differential diagnosis, and propose a management plan. They will then have to follow these patients on a daily basis, ensuring that they see all of their patients prior to daily rounds with the staff person. Outpatient experience is also available in the paediatric ID clinic once weekly. Teaching sessions will be provided by the staff person or residents rotating through the service.
