

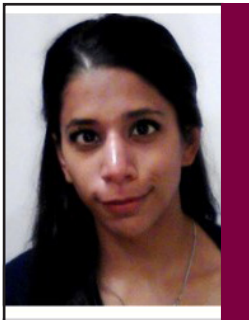
Pediatric Grand Rounds
