

Worker in a Hospital Building in an Office Environment

A worker is a person who performs work or supplies services for monetary compensation.

All workers have to participate in the safety education as required by McMaster University. Then they have to complete Fire Safety education as it relates to the building they work in. Additional safety education will relate to the type of tasks they perform. Finally, a worker must complete specific education sessions related to their role.

NOTE: The list you select will only list the basic education requirements. There may be other hazard-specific education requirements based on the hazard identifications for the work. There will be additional training requirements meant to bridge the education to the practical application of the information.
