

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE TEAM

You will have **20 minutes** for this TOSCE. During the 20 minutes, you must:

1. Review the information on this BLUE instruction card.
2. Review the information provided in the Pediatric Centre Recommendation Report. Note: Clinic chart has not arrived yet from previous clinic in Regina.
3. Discuss as a team, how you might proceed with Hannah.
4. Indicate when the meeting is over and provide a summary plan of care for Hannah.

Hannah Brill, 17 months old, is small for her age; she is crawling but is not yet walking or able to pull herself up. She only communicates with the word 'pah'. She can feed herself with her fingers, using the pincer-type grasp. Hannah, her mom, Brittany Sail, and dad, Brad Brill, moved to your local area from Regina four months ago. Hannah just started to attend Day Care, as Brittany decided to return to school to complete her high school diploma. The staff at the day care spoke with Brittany about their concerns regarding Hannah's development. They helped Brittany arrange an assessment for Hannah at the regional pediatric centre (by the child development team).

Due to transportation issues, Brittany is not able to go back to the clinic for any follow-up visits. Therefore, the assessment report has been sent to your office.

Your team is meeting to discuss how to support Brittany locally and follow up on the pediatric centre recommendations. Identify your local community resources and the providers within your practice who have the knowledge and skills to assist with this case. Discuss your strategy for management.

Using the skills specific to your discipline and the knowledge of the skills of others on your family health team, please proceed to develop a care plan to meet Hannah's needs.
